Action Verb Statements

When promoting yourself to future employers through a resume, you should express your skills, assets, experiences, and accomplishments in an active voice. Begin each descriptive statement with a strong action verb that describes what you did. As you create your statements, use a variety of action verbs throughout. The following is a sample list of action verbs you can use to create the statements that will reflect your discipline and skills, as well as enhance your resume.
